Design of materials and assignment of manuscripts to the editorial staff of the scientific-theoretical journal

«Vestnik of the Ulyanovsk state agricultural academy»

1. Articles are accepted for the publication if they follow basic scientific directions of the journal, contain new, never published before, results of scientific research, ready for practical application, as well as materials representing the cognitive interest.

2. Articles submitted to the editorial office are checked through the Anti-Plagiarism system (originality must be at least 80%) and undergo a review procedure.

3. The author submits the article in an electronic version by e-mail ridugsha@yandex.ru. Other options for providing articles are not provided.

Materials protected by the copyright law are published only with the written permission of the copyright holder. In connection with the inclusion of the journal in the Russian index of scientific citation (RISC), the author of the publication provides editorial team of the journal «Vestnik of the Ulyanovsk SAA» non-exclusive rights on the articles for publication.

4. For the timely publication of the article one must give to the editorial team 2 months before the release of the next issue the following:

- the letter of application in an arbitrary form, containing information about the author (s): full name, place of work, position, academic title, degree, the direction of studies, contact phone, address;

- text of the article in the paper (the computer printout) and electronic (CD, or E-mail, format - MS Word 97-2007) versions, fully coincide with each other;

5. Design of an article:

- maximum volume of 10 - 14 pages of A4 format text, typed in Times New Roman, size 14 PT 1,5-spaced, without any formatting;

- tables are performed by regular means of MS Word or imported from MS Excel (without extraneous information);

- drawings and diagrams should be black-and-white or grayscale; the elements of the vector images should be grouped; resolution of the raster images (photos, scans) - at least 300 dpi.

- lists are numbered and marked manually (in order to avoid loss of formatting in layout);

- notes are issued in the form of ordinary (not the limit!) footnotes by regular means of MS Word;

- formulas are made in the programme of Math Type and transfer in the article;

- Bibliography is placed at the end of the article. The number of sources used in the article should be no less than 14. The sources are in the order of citation and issued in accordance with the GOST 7.1 2003.

Numbered references to them are given in the text of the article in square brackets in the usual text format;

- when typing text, the non-standard fonts (for example, the font of the national languages, specialized symbolic fonts) should be avoided.

6. The article structure:

- the index of UDC (on the left);
- the title of the article (in CAPITAL LETTERS);
- surname, name, scientific degree, scientific title of the author (s), the name of the organization where they work, legal address, telephone, e-mail address;
- key words (5-7);
- a brief summary of 40-50 words;
- summary: the volume of 200-250 words, no more than 2000 characters (you need to highlight the relevance, the aim of the research, materials and methods, results (preferably with lots of quantitative data), clearly formulate the conclusions);
- the text of the article with the included illustrations (tables, figures).

Desirable building:

- **Introduction**
- **Materials and methods**
- **Research results**
- **Discussion**
- **Conclusion**
- **Bibliography**

9. The authors are responsible for the accuracy and originality of materials.
